COUNCILLOR CLEM

WHEREAS: This City Council has previously requested the Cambridge Housing Authority to improve its method of rubbish collection at Woodrow Wilson Court and at the Turnkey Housing Development located at Fairmont Avenue and Magazine Street; and

WHEREAS: There is no enclosed dumpster on Fairmont Avenue or central garbage disposal area, resulting in an unsightly appearance; and

WHEREAS: The Cambridge Housing Authority in a previous communication to this City Council had outlined steps they planned to take in order to correct both of the above mentioned problems; yet to date nothing has been done; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to ask the Cambridge Housing Authority to take prompt action to:

1. Expand the Recycling Program to include Woodrow Wilson Court as well as to make arrangements for a dumpster and/or a compaction system, said proposal to be included in the Cambridge Housing Authority modernization plans, and
2. To create a centralized garbage collection area on Fairmont Avenue, properly screened from the sidewalk and general public.
