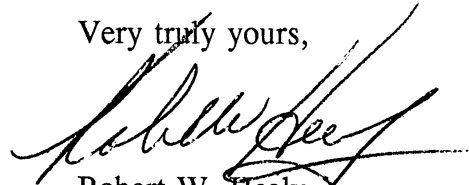

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of a grant from the Department of Public Health for \$50,334.00 to the Health and Hospital Services Salaries & Wages Account (\$25,000) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$25,334) to provide for anonymous voluntary ATS services provided in state co-operating community health centers. This clinic provides clients with information in the risk factors that maybe related to HIV infection in different client populations, technical information on the implications of receiving a positive or negative test results, and a HIV antibody test if required.
