The number of bicyclists on the streets continue to be a source of some danger for themselves and for automobile drivers; and

**WHEREAS:**

Secretary Brinigar has called a National Conference on Bicycles U.S.A. to be held in Cambridge, Mass. on May 7th and 8th, 1973; therefore be it

**ORDERED:**

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to revive the Citizens Bicycle Committee and to prepare for the City Council proposals to make bicycle movement through the city safer and more agreeable;

**AND BE IT FURTHER ORDERED:**

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to assign adequate staff members from the Planning Department to this conference and to direct all appropriate departments to cooperate with the planning of the conference
