**AN ORDINANCE**

In amendment to an ordinance formerly entitled: "The General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge" as revised in 1972 and now designated as "The Code of the City of Cambridge."

**Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:**

Chapter 16, Article 1 entitled: "Hackney Carriages" is hereby amended by adding a new section 16-24A entitled: "Toll Charges" as follows: **Section 16-24A. Toll Charges.**

Drivers of Hackney Carriages, propelled by mechanical motors and using taximeters, may charge and demand for services rendered in conveying passengers to Logan Airport or to any point requiring the use of the Callahan and Sumner Tunnels a fee of fifty cents (\$.50).
