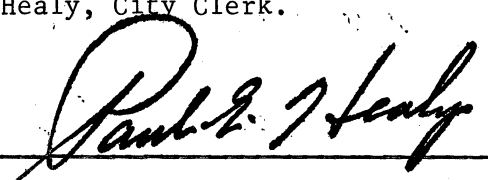
MAYOR RUSSELL
