The Committee on Roads & Bridges to which was referred the petition of W. L. Libbey & son, and others praying that the strip of land at the junction of Gas and Bridge street may be taken by City and kept open as a public square,

Reports,

That your Committee has heard the petitioners in the matter referred to, and the desirability of securing the land at the junction of Gas and Bridge streets has been forcibly presented. Said land is now used by the public and has been so used for many years, although it is occasionally fenced to save the rights of the owner. As the taking of the same by the city would involve an expenditure of the sum of \$1300.- and upwards, and there is no appropriation to which such an outlay would be chargeable, your committee must ^{therefore} recommend that the petitioners have leave to withdraw.
