WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of the Cambridge City Council that the West Cambridge Minors won the 2008 Little League All-Star Tournament; and

WHEREAS: West Cambridge won the first game of the 2008 All-Star Tournament, by defeating North Cambridge 4-3 in an extra innings nail biter. It took a full 8 innings for the West bats to overcome a brilliant 8 inning pitching performance by North's Matthew McGaffigan. The West victory was led by 3 innings of excellent pitching from starter Soren McLeod followed by 5 equally strong innings of relief from Ross Baker. The winning run came in the top of the eighth inning on a sacrifice fly hit to deep Center Field by West's Sam Mazer, and the West Defense held firm in the bottom of the ninth. The West's other three runs were driven in by Colin Mullen (2) and Ross Harrison; and

WHEREAS: West won the second game of the 2008 All-Star Tournament, by defeating East in an equally dramatic pitchers' duel for the first 5 innings. West pitching was once again led by starter Soren McLeod (3), closer Ross Baker (1), with Ross Harrison contributing two key innings of mid-relief. It was another pitchers' duel supported by Major league caliber defense on both sides of the field. However, the score tied 1-1 through 4 innings, West managed to manufacture a key run in the top of the fifth inning to take a 2-1 lead. After narrowly escaping a bases loaded jam in the bottom of the 5th, the West bats finally erupted in the top of the 6th, with an explosive 10-run performance by West; with RBI's driven in by Colin Mullen (2), Sam Denney (2), Sam Cabot, Liam Simmons, Daniel Walsh, Silas Monahan, Soren McLeod, and Ross Baker; now therefore be it
