John P. Sousa, Jr. of 23 Elm Street, Cambridge, a resident of that neighborhood all of his life, was inducted into the military service on March 20, 1943 from Cambridge, and

WHEREAS:-

John P. Sousa, Jr. was but nineteen years of age when he entered the service of his country and was assigned to Battery C, 228th Field Artillery Battalion and served with distinction, and

WHEREAS:-

John P. Sousa, Jr. was killed in action on April 21, 1944 before his twentieth birthday, therefore be it

RESOLVED:-

That the City Council of the City of Cambridge in session assembled acknowledges with deep sympathy the great sacrifice made by John P. Sousa, Jr. and records itself in favor of naming the Fletcher School play area located on Elm Street the "John P. Sousa Jr. Playground".
