

# City of Cambridge.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred  
and Seventy-one.

An Ordinance  
in relation to protection from fire.

Be it ordained by the City Council of  
Cambridge, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Aldermen upon  
to knowledge by Complaint or otherwise,  
and view of any defective or dangerous  
chimney or fire place in the City, shall  
provide that the same be examined and  
inspected, and when it shall deem that the  
safety of the city so requires, shall order the  
same to be forthwith repaired or taken down  
and demolished -

Section 2. If the owner of any such chimney  
or fire-place, after having received or had left  
at his residence or place of business, a copy  
of an order of the Board of Aldermen,  
attested by the Clerk, to repair or take down  
the same, fails so to do, he shall be liable  
to a fine of twenty dollars.

Section 3. The Board of Aldermen may cause such chimney or fireplace to be taken down and abated as a common nuisance at the expense of the owner thereof.
