

Mortgage Deed of Personal Property

Know all men by these presents,
That I Solomon C. Calef of Medford
in the County of Middlesex and Common-
-wealth of Massachusetts

In consideration of the sum of Four
Hundred Dollars to me paid by Washington
Hobart of Boston in the County of Suffolk and
State aforesaid, do hereby bargain, sell and
convey to him or his representatives, One
Gutter Machine, one Rounding Machine, Three
Saws, and all the shafting, Pulleys, Belting,
Moulding Irons or other appurtenances belong-
to said Machine, meaning to convey all
that I have this day bought of said Hobart
and all improvements that may be made
or added to said Machines within four
Months from this date, to have and to hold
the same to his use & behoof forever

The condition of this sale is such
that if the said Calef or his representatives
shall well & truly pay or cause to be paid
to the said Hobart or his representatives, Three
promissory notes bearing even date herewith,

It is understood & agreed by the parties
that said Calip is to ^{have} the possession and use
of said Machine until a breach of the condi-
tion of sale occurs

according to the tenor of the same, said notes
amounting to said sum of Four Hundred
Dollars, then this ^{note} is to be void, otherwise to
remain in full force & virtue
