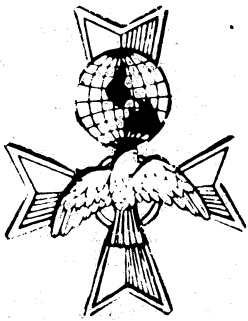

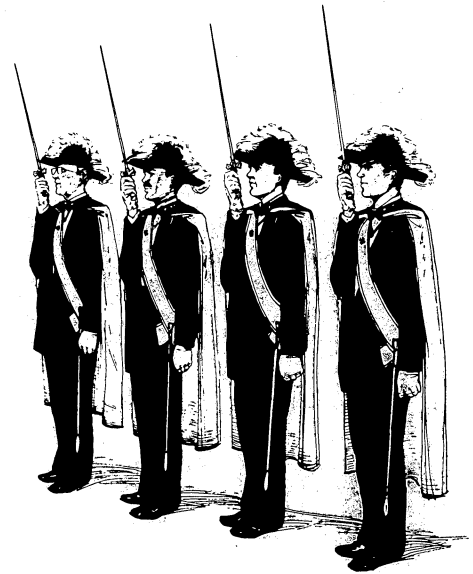

Entered Cardinal O'Connell Minor Seminary in September, 1956. Entered St. John's Seminary In September, 1958. Ordained at Gate of Heaven Church, South Boston on February 5, 1964 by the late Cardinal Cushing.



His first assignment was at St. Richard's Parish in Danvers from February, 1964 to June, 1967; a temporary administrator of St. John's Parish, Haverhill from June, 1967 to January, 1968. Then He was assigned to Blessed Sacrament Parish, Cambridge from January, 1968 to June 6, 1972. From there He went to St. John's Parish in Winthrop, after serving there He was sent to St. Brendan's Parish in Dorchester, He is now at Holy Redeemer Parish in East Boston. He was appointed Chaplain of Cambridge Council #74 Knights of Columbus in September of 1971. In 1973 He was appointed Faithful Friar of our Great Assembly.
