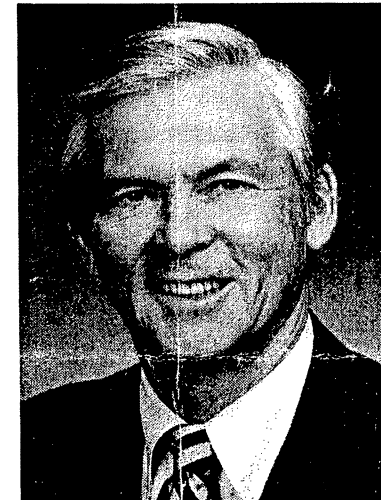
Let us now praise famous
