That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to the Apostolic Pentecostal Church for the erection of a banner across Massachusetts Avenue, from Purity Supreme Market to Essex Street in Central Square on July 26 through August 9, 1982.

Provided that before erecting the above named banner, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner.
