City of Cambridge: CAMBRIDGE, MASS.

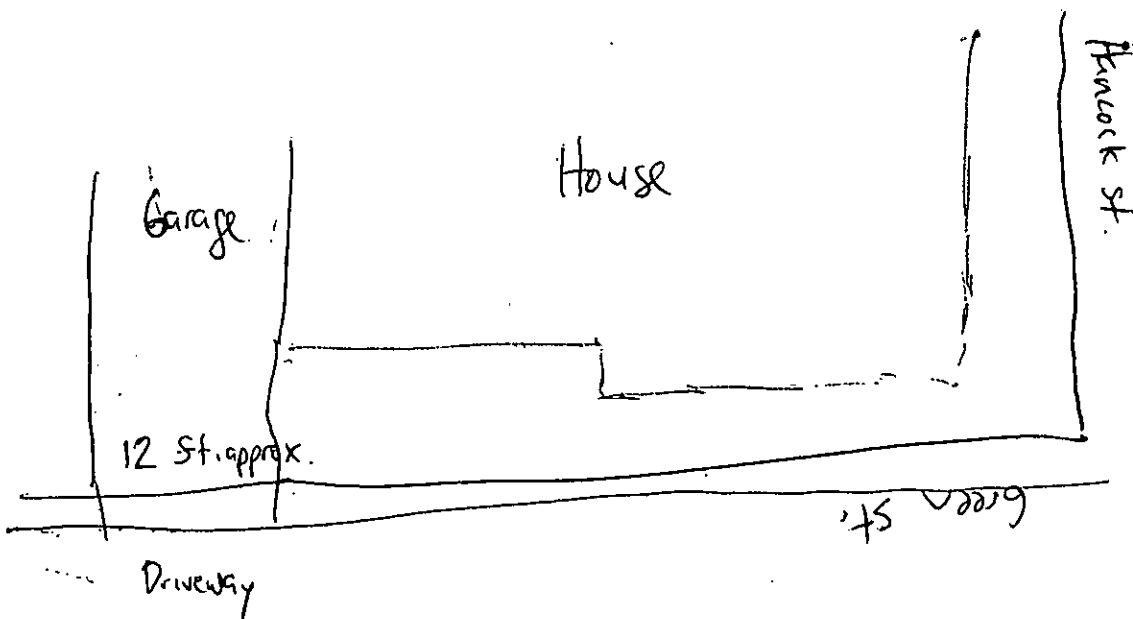
