WHEREAS: The Cambridge Housing Assistance Fund (CHAF) is a broad-based community partnership of businesses, institutions, individuals and community leaders committed to preserving the diversity and character of the city of Cambridge by providing an economical bridge to housing for homeless and near homeless families and individuals; and

WHEREAS: Since 1999, CHAF has raised more than \$1,200,000, assisting people in nearly 1300 households to make the transition from life in a shelter or street to a safe home and enabling others to avoid homelessness by retaining their homes; and

WHEREAS: In order to continue to support their excellent work, CHAF will sponsor HomeSweetHome, a dessert and port/wine tasting on November 14, 2008 at the Hyatt Regency Cambridge; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record as thanking the partners of the Cambridge Housing Assistance Fund for their tireless efforts to stamp out homelessness in Cambridge and wishing them well for the HomeSweetHome event; and be it further
