COUNCILLOR WOLF

- WHEREAS: Street repair throughout Cambridge represents a major expense to the City and it is a waste of money to repave streets only to determine they have to be ripped up almost immediately; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to establish a procedure which would ensure that the City contact all public and private utilities which have underground facilities through Cambridge, as well as the appropriate City departments, such as the Water Department, as well as American Cablevision, in order to determine which streets are expected to be excavated for repairs during the upcoming fiscal year; and be it further
- ORDERED: That no streets on these lists be slated for repair by the City until any other work which needs to be done is completed; and be it further
- ORDERED: That property owners abutting streets which will be repaired by the City, be given notice and an opportunity to replace or repair water pipes prior to street construction.
