- WHEREAS: Our city faces increased hunger and homelessness in the lives of its most vulnerable citizens; and
- WHEREAS: Our city resolves that the alleviation of such suffering is paramount in its responsibility of governing; and
- WHEREAS: Our city supports the right to every Cambridge citizen to adequate food and housing; and
- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Department of Human Service Programs, the Cambridge Economic Opportunity Committee, the Cambridge Food Pantry Network, the Cambridge Clergy, represented by the Harvard and Central Square Clergy Associations and the Black Pastors' Conference, have joined together in a collaborative effort calling for a community-wide "week" of action and reflection; and
- WHEREAS: This "week" shall focus on remedying the shortages which create hunger and homelessness; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council does hereby declare November 12-24, 1989, as **Hunger/Homeless Action Week: Feeding the Hungry—Housing the Homeless**, and does hereby call on all businesses, churches, corporations, and individuals to aid in the alleviation of hunger and homelessness in our community.
