- WHEREAS: The quality and effectiveness of the facilities, as well as their planning, design, and construction are vitally dependent upon the efforts and skill of Public Works officials; and
- WHEREAS: The efficiency of the qualified and dedicated personnel who staff Public Works departments is materially influenced by the people's attitude and understanding of the importance of the work they perform; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council do hereby proclaim May 20-26, 1984, as NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK in Cambridge, and call upon all citizens and civic organizations to acquaint themselves with the problems involved in providing our Public Works and to recognize the contributions that Public Works officials make everyday to our health, safety, and comfort.
