Chap. 495. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE
TO MAKE CERTAIN TEMPORARY, PROVISIONAL
LABOR SERVICE EMPLOYEES PERMANENT AS OF
JANUARY FIRST, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-TWO.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, any employee of the city of Cambridge serving as a temporary or provisional employee in a labor service position and who was so employed prior to January first, nineteen hundred and eighty-two, and who has served continuously since that date, shall be permanent in that position held as of January first, nineteen hundred and eighty-two; provided, however, that such employee's name, title, department and date of employment appears on a list dated October eleventh, nineteen hundred and eighty-three which is on file with the director of technical services of the department of personnel administration.
