MAYOR DANEHY

ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to have the Water Department properly notify the water users of Cambridge on the exact location of the Water Department for the purpose of questioning their water bill.

It is further requested that all new changes of address of City Agencies be included in a general mailing, such as a tax bill, to the taxpayers of the City, and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to take the necessary action to replace the terminology on the water bill which reads "Water Arrears" and substitute in place thereof the words "Water Bill" and be it further

ORDERED: That an explanation of the term "Colofom Count" be made in language understandable by the average person, and be it further

ORDERED: That anytime the water level reaches a high state of impurity, that this City Council be notified as soon as possible.
