- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Traffic and Parking Department to synchronize the light at the corner of Walden and Sherman Street, to allow for a longer period of time where the traffic is stopped in 4 directions during the time when children are going and coming from School, due to the fact that between 25 and 30 children in the area are picked up at both the corner of Walden Street, Sherman Street, and Garden Street and Walden Street by the school bus; and be it further
- ORDERED: That if that is not completed by the first day of school that a crossing guard be assigned to that corner until such time as the intersection can be made as safe as possible for the children in the area; and be it further
- ORDERED: To report back at the next Council meeting as to the progress in this situation.
