

CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

In Common Council, *Nov 15* 1882

Ordered,

That the City Engineer, in conjunction with the City Engineer of the City of Boston, be requested to prepare and submit preliminary plans and estimates of the cost of the proposed new bridge between Boston and Cambridge: the expense attending the preparation of said plans and estimates, not to exceed the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, to be paid one-half by the City of Boston, and one-half by this city. That portion borne by this city to be charged to the appropriation for Incidental Expenses.
