To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$29,732.00 from the Human Services Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to Human Services Salary and Wages Account. During preparation of the annual budget, all anticipated Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds that will be awarded to community agencies are placed into the Professional Technical Services category for the purpose of contract payments. During the FY95 CDBG award process, funds were granted to two DHSP agencies - the Council on Aging and the Community Learning Center. These funds will be used to pay direct staff through the City payroll system. These staff members will be working on the specific projects for which CDBG funds were awarded.
