### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

On August 29, 1985, pursuant to G.L. c. 30A, sec. 2, the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") issued emergency amendments to regulations concerning the Commercial Motor Vehicle Division ("CMVD"), specifically the amendment of 220 C.M.R. 250.01 and the repeal of 220 C.M.R. 250.02. These amendments rescinded the delegation of authority that authorized the Director or Assistant Director of CMVD to issue decisions pursuant to 220 C.M.R. 250.02, and revested that authority with the Department.

On October 1, 1985, the Department issued a second set of emergency regulations concerning the CMVD, specifically the repeal of 220 C.M.R. 271.01 and 220 C.M.R. 271.02; and the further amendment of 220 C.M.R. 250.01. These second amendments rescinded the delegation of authority that authorized the Director or Assistant Director of CMVD to issue decisions regarding the transfer or assignment of licenses, permits and certificates and revested that authority with the Department.

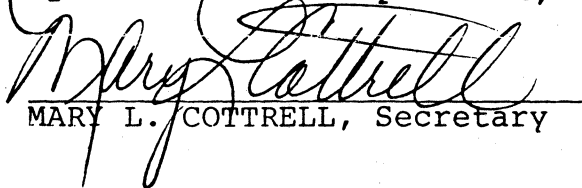
The Department will hold a public hearing on October 29, 1985, at 10:00 A.M. at the Department's offices, 100 Cambridge Street, 12th Floor, Boston, Massachusetts to determine whether

the emergency regulations issued on August 29, 1985 and the emergency regulations issued on October 1, 1985 should be adopted on a permanent basis. A copy of the Department's Orders of August 29, 1985 and October 1, 1985 are available from the Secretary, Department of Public Utilities, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, MA 02202. The Department will also consider whether it is necessary or appropriate to continue to include any delegations pursuant to G.L. c. 25, sec. 12F in the Department's formal regulations, as published in the Code of Massachusetts Regulations.

Oral presentation of data, views or arguments relating to the proposal may be submitted by any interested person at the public hearing.

All parties interested in submitting written comments are asked to do so no later than 5:00 P.M., November 8, 1985, to the Secretary of the Department of Public Utilities, at the above address. Any questions regarding the procedures to be followed should be directed to the Hearing Officer, Robert Shapiro, at 727-3500.
