WHEREAS: The grant will provide support for the 18-piece orchestra which will produce *New Ideas in Jazz : The Big Band*, a concert of original music supplemented by lecture-demonstrations for the general public, and a clinic for musicians of the MIT Festival Jazz Ensemble; and
