

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, Dec. 21. 1859.

Ordered, whereas it is adjudged by the Mayor and Aldermen that the public convenience and necessity require that Lane Street, between Howard Street and Broadway, be laid out as a public highway, -

Ordered, That said Street be and hereby is laid out and established as a public highway, by the name of Lane Street, between said points the easterly line of said Street to be the easterly line as delineated in a Plan of said Street drawn by W. A. Mason & Co. bearing date Nov. 16. 1859. and now before this Board; said Street to be forty feet in width and to lie on the westerly side of said line above mentioned.

Ordered, That no damages be allowed to any person for any land taken under this Order for the purpose above mentioned.
