- WHEREAS: Mr. Margetson leaves his sisters, Marie Scott, of Somerville, Ruth Fowler and Edith Margetson of Boston, and Norma Greenidge of Cambridge, his brother Rupert Margetson of Cambridge, all who will miss him very much; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending their deepest sympathy to the family and friends of George Margetson, Jr. at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
