AN ACT Authorizing the re-instatement of William G. Maher to his former position of patrolman in the Police Department of the City of Cambridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Director of Civil Service upon request of the appointing authority of the City of Cambridge shall re - instate William G. Maher to the position of patrolman in the Police Department of said city, a position formerly held by William G. Maher, provided the said appointing authority submits to the Director of Civil Service in writing the reasons why such re - instatement would be in the public interest.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts
in General Court assembled.
