- WHEREAS: It was reported in Cambridge Chronicle issue December 31, 1987, that a "bank robber is being charged with two robberies and an attempted robbery." All incidents took place in Harvard Square; and
- WHEREAS: The bank robber was apprehended on December 29 after allegedly robbing the Coolidge Bank and Trust Company on Mt. Auburn Street in Cambridge, after the description of the suspect was dispatched on the Cambridge Police Radio; and
- WHEREAS: Harvard Square patrol Officer, Benny Cappello, observed the suspect from the window of a Harvard Square Restaurant, the "Tasty". Officer Cappello saw the suspect walking in front of the Harvard Trust Bank on J.F.K. Street, and followed him until he was ten or fifteen feet behind the suspect, in front of the Harvard Coop. The suspect was arrested and booked by the Cambridge Police Department. Officer Tonilyn Lee and Sgt. Thomas O'Connor assisted Officer Benny Cappello in the arrest; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record commending the arresting Officer Benny Cappello, and Officer Tonilyn Lee and Sgt. Thomas O'Connor in their outstanding performance as police officers in the Cambridge Police Department.
