- WHEREAS: Sister Madeline Mary, formerly Sister Mary Florentine, spent her entire life devoted to God and to the teaching profession which she enjoyed and in which she excelled; and
- WHEREAS: Many past and present Cambridge residents have had the privilege in their formative years of meeting and being taught by Sister Madeline Mary, and by so doing, were able to develop a thirst for learning and an understanding that in order to succeed in life one must work hard; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Sister Madeline Mary S.S.N.D. as well as to the members of her religious community at Saint Peter's Convent at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to both the family as well as to the Convent, on behalf of the entire City Council.
