To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to City Council Order No. 9 of March 31, 1986, a committee has been formed to organize a comprehensive citywide clean-up. In previous years, such a program proved to be less than successful due to scheduling problems and the lack of an adequate number of volunteers. To ensure a more effective program this year, the committee has decided to move the date of clean-up to a weekday in late July. This year's clean-up will rely on the 700 youngsters who participate in the city's various summer youth programs. The directors of these programs, representing the Mayor's Office, the Department of Human Service Programs, and local nonprofit agencies, have participated in the committee's decisions and have agreed to incorporate the clean-up day in their summer programming. When the official clean-up date is set, other neighborhood, church, and youth organizations will be invited to participate.
