IN CITY COUNCIL
June 7, 1976

ORDERED:

That in accordance with the provisions of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge, Chapter 3, Section 3-2, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Donald A. Levy, doing business as Goods Department Store, for the purpose of displaying and selling merchandise for their First Anniversary Celebration on the sidewalk in front of the premises numbered 11-23 Boylston Street during the period June 10-19, 1976 provided that no such permit shall be granted to exceed more than one-third of the width of the sidewalk from the property line of the premises in front of which said display shall be installed and providing further that before erecting the above named display, the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said display.

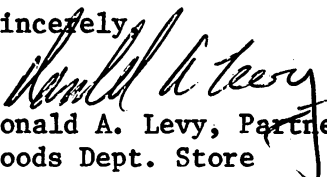
