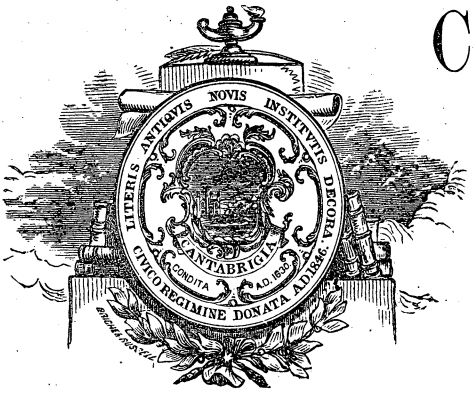

October 25th 1871

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Elliot Street at its junction with Brattle Square should be widened, and that the lines of No^t Auburn Street between Brighton & Elliot Streets should be established. Therefore

~~should be laid out as a public Street.~~ Ordered that a strip of land *of unequal width*
~~in width between~~

belonging to the Heirs of E A Chapman, deceased,

included between the ~~red & black~~ lines as shown on a plan drawn by *J G Chase*
City Engineer dated October 24th 1871

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid.

as follows.

To Heirs of E A Chapman 322 sq feet of land \$1.00 per ft. \$322.00
" " " " For moving 120 feet of fence 50¢ " " 60.00
\$382.00

Ordered. That 14 days be allowed to the persons whose land is taken for said widening, for the removal of their fences, and other property standing on the land so taken as aforesaid.
