COUNCILLOR DANEHY

WHEREAS: The gates at the railroad crossing at Massachusetts Avenue and Cameron Avenue continue to present a serious problem to both pedestrians and motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS: Vandals cause these gates to come down as often as several times in a single day or evening; and

WHEREAS: This kind of vandalism is causing a severe hazard to motor vehicles and to the public safety of the neighborhood since emergency apparatus cannot get by the crossing gates until a repair crew comes to correct the problem; and

WHEREAS: The MBTA is currently the owner of these gate facilities; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to contact the appropriate individuals at the MBTA to insure that a gate crossing guard is restored to the Massachusetts Avenue and Cameron Avenue location at least until the completion of the Red Line Extension.
