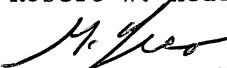

Subject Council Order No. 21 - 10/18/82 Re: Brookford Street

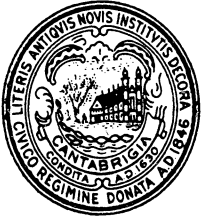
I have been talking to Mr. Robert Fawcett of Fawcett Oil Company concerning the fence and gate that was installed at the end of Brookford Street. Mr. Fawcett has stated that the fence and gate installed at this location was installed after a fire damaged his building and a wall had to be removed.

He also stated that he has no intention of using this gate for his vehicles and only will be used in case of fire. All fire vehicles carry bolt cutters and a fire at his plant would require access from Brookford Street to protect those houses.

It is my opinion that a permanent barrier would cause a delay in reaching the fire. Therefore, I suggest that no barrier be installed and if we find the gate being used we can then take any action we desire.
