Voted that the City Council file with the legislature a special act entitled, An act authorizing local voting rights in school board elections for non-citizens residing in Cambridge, as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one of chapter fifty-one of the general laws, or any other general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, non-citizens eighteen years or older and who reside in the city of Cambridge may, upon application, have their names entered on a list of voters, established by the city clerk, for the city of Cambridge and may thereafter vote in any election for school board members and school board questions.

Section 2. The City Council of Cambridge is authorized to formulate regulations, guidelines and a registration form to implement the purpose of this act. The voter registration form shall include a declaration to
