June 15, 1987

ORDERED:

That the City Council establish a general policy to be used by the City Manager for granting permits for use of the Cambridge Common by groups and further that this policy be that permits for use of the Common be granted with the following restrictions:

- (1) No vehicles be allowed to drive onto the Common;
- (2) No alcoholic beverages be served;
- (3) No amplified music be allowed;
- (4) No food stands be allowed on the Waterhouse end of the Common;
- (5) No interference with groups using the playing field be allowed; and,
- (6) The timing must be such that groups do not interfere with each other or other activities scheduled in Cambridge;
- (7) That a bond be posted to protect the City against damage;
- (8) That the City Manager designate a person, department or agency of the City to schedule and coordinate the proper use of the Common with approved groups, to monitor each use at all times, with the power to discontinue immediately any event which does not adhere to posted rules and regulations;
- (9) Proper Police details be required;
- (10) Public toilets be required for large groups;
- (11) Develop and post a list of rules and regulations.

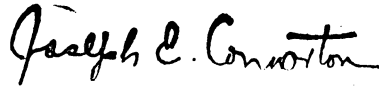

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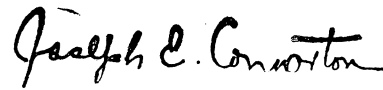
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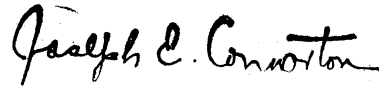
