In compliance with the attached Council Order, the undersigned inspected the Hews Pottery on June 14, 1955.

A new plant has been erected on this property to permit gathering or harvest of clay irrespective of weather conditions. In past years, this work could be done only on dry summer days. Last year was cool and wet in the summer, and the clay supply was reduced to the point of building the new plant or closing the business.

In this addition the clay is crushed and at present, hauled by trucks to the storage sheds. Considerable dust is released. A covered conveyor system to transport the clay has been ordered and should be in service by July 15. This system not only will eliminate trucking, but also will bring about an overall improvement at the Hews property as far as the dust problem is concerned.

It is recommended that any further action be deferred pending completion of the new plant. At that time further inspection of the dust conditions will be made when the plant is in operation.


