ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to establish a task force comprised of those Cambridge residents and employees who have been attending the meetings of the Alewife Task Force discussing the proposed subway station and the remodeling of Route 2, and be it further

ORDERED:

That this task force be requested to propose for adoption by this City Council, policies in the following areas, but which shall not be limited to these areas:

1. A policy on appropriate size of the remodeled roadway and its feeders, and the number and kind of motor vehicles they can carry.
2. A policy on providing for the free mobility and safety of pedestrians and bicyclists in the whole area.
3. A policy on preservation of free open space, recreational areas and wetlands in the area.
4. A policy on land use, and be it further

ORDERED:

That said task force need not wait until the whole task is finished before reporting back to the Council but should report as soon as it reaches agreement on a policy, and be it further

ORDERED:

That the manager is directed to make this a matter of urgency and to make sure that there is a strong Cambridge spokesman for such policies as the Council adopts.
