



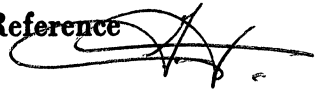

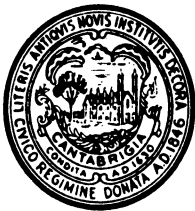
Subject Council Order #2 11/19/90

The outdoor lighting at Neville Manor is in need of improvement, but it will take approximately two months to draft specifications for the project. The earliest possible time for the installation to start would be during the spring of 1991.

As a temporary solution to make immediate improvements, this department has proposed installing two flood lights on the east side of the building to illuminate the area of the loading dock, and to install two poles with flood lights in the other parking areas, on the west and north sides. These temporary improvements could be realized before January 1991.

The Cambridge Hospital has given approval for the installation of the temporary lighting, and is looking to progress with a permanent solution.
