- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Deputy Chief Joseph L. Healey has retired from active duty on the Cambridge Fire Department; and
- WHEREAS: Deputy Chief Healey was first appointed to the department on February 16, 1941 at which time he was assigned to Ladder Company 2 where he remained until he entered the Military Service on December 13, 1943; and
- WHEREAS: Firefighter Healey returned to active fire duty on December 16, 1945 and on April 15, 1951 was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant and was assigned to Engine 3 until November 11, 1951 when he was transferred to Ladder Company 1; and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Healey was promoted again on July 11, 1954 to the rank of Captain and on February 2, 1965 promoted to his present rank of Deputy Chief; and
- WHEREAS: Deputy Chief Healey was a dedicated member of the department being specifically commended in General Orders in 1956, 1960 and 1964 all of which indicated Deputy Chief Healey has set an outstanding example for all fire fighters to follow; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Deputy Fire Chief Joseph L. Healey for his tremendous and continuous devotion to duty throughout his 36 years with the department; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this City Council extend to Deputy Chief Healey our very best wishes for a healthy and happy retirement; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Deputy Chief Healey on behalf of the entire City Council.
