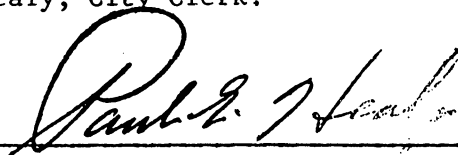

Enclosed herewith you will find the petition of James T. & Anna Benson

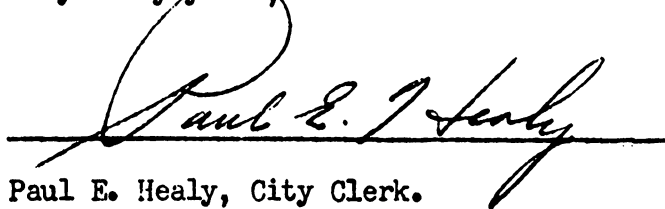
requesting a driveway at the premises numbered

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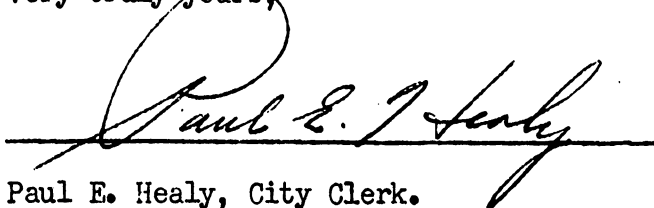

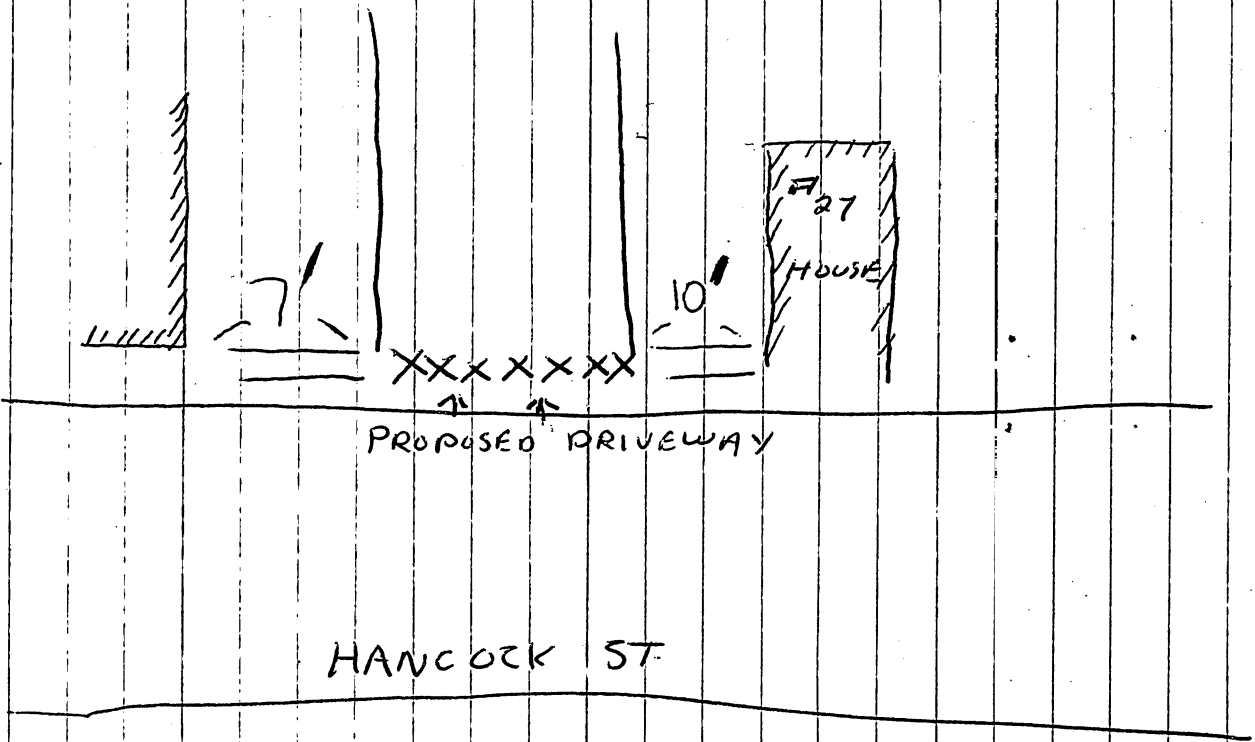
