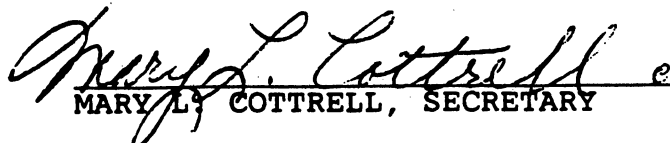

The petitioner, Southnet Corporation, is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date in the Boston Globe, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and The Evening Gazette (Worcester), and to serve a copy hereof at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date on all parties on the attached list, and to make return of service and publication at the time of the hearing.
