





Frank S. Maragioglio, 58 years of age of 305 Hurley Street, Cambridge, Mass., is a native of Boston and upon graduation from East Boston High School became a resident of East Cambridge where he met and married the former Miss Sarah Rego in 1932, an East Cambridge resident.

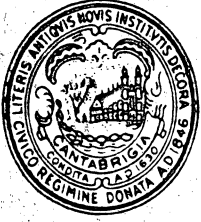
Father of five children, all products of the Cambridge School system, he has nine grandchildren. His son Dennis James Maragioglio presently a Junior at Cambridge High and Latin School has excelled in hockey there and is a member of Cambridge High and Latin School football team.

A Disabled Veteran of World War II, Mr. Maragioglio had the distinction of being one of the first married men with children in Cambridge to join the Armed Services at the start of World War II. For six consecutive years he served as a member of the National Guard, 101st Engineers Medical Detachment with the rank of Sergeant. Although married and the father of four children, in 1942 he volunteered to join the Army and became attached to the 200th Ordnance Depot Company with the rank of Sergeant.

Shortly after basic training in the regular Army, he was assigned to overseas duty which took him to England, Belgium, France and Germany in the European Theatre. A Disabled Veteran, he was honorably discharged from the U.S. Army in October of 1945.

Employed as an Inspector with the Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities, Gas Division, he has served in that capacity for the past twenty years.

Twice Vice-Chairman of the Cambridge Housing Authority, he was appointed a Commissioner of Housing in Cambridge in 1964, serving in that capacity through 1968. A member of Cambridge Lodge of Elks #839, he is identified also with various other clubs and organizations of Cambridge.



Mr. Maragioglio's term will expire on October 29, 1971 and Mr. Coughlin's term will expire on October 29, 1972.

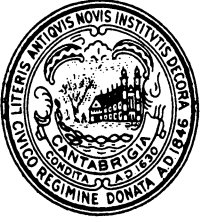


