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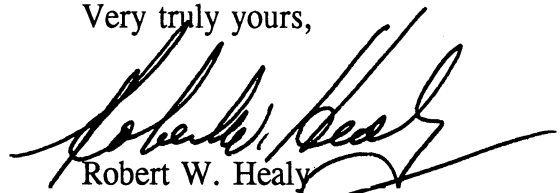

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of a grant from the Massachusetts Highway Department for \$234,800.00 to the Grant Fund Community Development Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to provide funds for the design costs related to the Lafayette Square Roadway Improvement Project.

This project will reorient Lafayette Square by extending Sidney Street from Massachusetts Avenue to Main Street through the existing gasoline station thereby creating a new plaza in the area. In addition, Massachusetts Avenue will be completely reconstructed within the existing right-of-way from Lafayette Square to Memorial Drive. The entire project will include new sidewalks, bike lanes, updated traffic signalization, improved street lighting, and appropriate landscaping/urban design amenities.
