WHEREAS: The trees, flowers and shrubs have added much to the uniqueness of our urban park. It has been brought to my attention that some of the pine trees, have turned brown and are diseased even before winter had set in; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Public Works Department, Acting Commissioner, to discuss whatever measures can be taken, to request the contractor to replace these dead trees, since they were just planted in the summer of 1990; and be it further

ORDERED: That a complete report be given to the City Council in the near future.
