The petitioner, National Accounts, Inc., is required to complete the following: (1) Give notice by publication hereof once, on or before January 14, 1994 [which is twenty-one (21) days prior to February 4, 1994], in the Boston Globe, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and the Worcester Telegram; (2) Give notice by mailing a copy hereof on or before January 14, 1994 to the Local Exchange and Other Common Carriers on the attached Interexchange Carriers list; and (3) Make return of service and publication no later than February 11, 1994.
