A copy of this order, certified by the City Clerk, shall be recorded forthwith in the Middlesex South District Registry of Deeds.

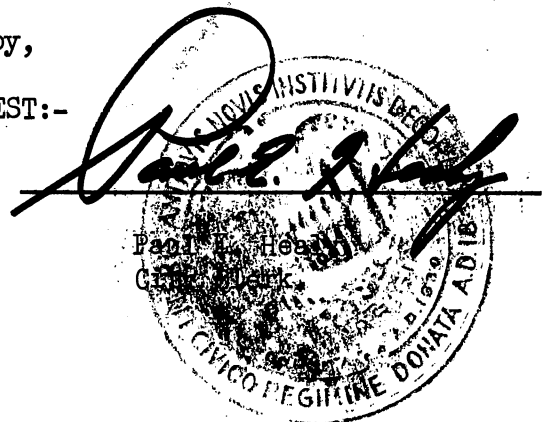

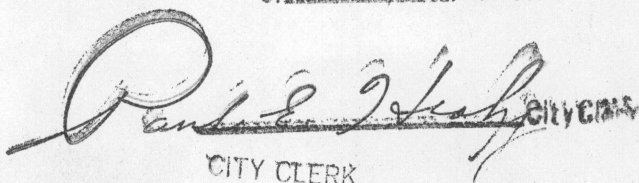
