VALUE-ADDED COMMUNICATIONS, INC.

Value-Added Communications, Inc. ("Value-Added"), a Delaware corporation, seeks permission from the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") to provide telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Value-Added proposes to offer a variety of telecommunications services, including operator services and transmission to hotels, motels, hospitals, and privately-owned pay telephones.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

Application of Value-Added Communications, Inc. to the Department of Public Utilities, under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws, as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale, value-added, or interexchange common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Value-Added has also filed a proposed tariff of rates and charges for the provision of these transmission services and operator services within the Commonwealth. Value-Added's proposed tariff has been suspended until August 16, 1991.

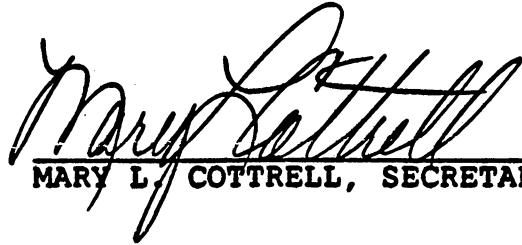
The above investigation is officially captioned:

The Department will conduct a public hearing on all of the above matters on Monday, June 10, 1991, at 10:00 a.m., at the Department's Hearing Room 1210, Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02202.

Value-Added Communications, Inc. is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once, at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said hearing in the Boston Globe, the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield), the Springfield Union News, and the Worcester Telegram, and to serve a copy hereof at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the hearing date on the parties on the attached list, and to make a return of service and publication, to include the original clippings of the newspaper publications, at the time of the hearing.
