- WHEREAS:** On the week of October 2, 1998, the parishioners of St. Mary's Antiochian Orthodox Church of Cambridge, Massachusetts will be celebrating the 70th anniversary of their house of worship and the final payment of their church and parish home mortgages; and
- WHEREAS:** St. Mary's is the second oldest church in the City of Cambridge, existing at its present location at 8 Inman Street for the past 47 years, contains one of the largest collections of pre-Civil War stained glass windows in the country, is listed on the national historical register and holds deep historic significance for the City of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS:** This parish has an extremely diversified membership, including parishioners from Russia, Ethiopia, Albania, Syria and Lebanon, all worshipping together while building strong bonds with each other and the community; and
- WHEREAS:** Saint Mary's is highly involved with the community, devoting its time and resources to the YWCA, the annual international festival and the Cambridge food pantry; now therefore be it
